

COMPOSITION: Due 5/4 (2 weeks)

Dear Students,

I very much miss seeing your faces and hearing your voices, and I especially miss our in-class discussions! I would like you to write your Composition assignment this week about your experience with being home under the Governor's stay-home order, since school became homeschool! Please double-space, and use a black or blue pen.

TITLE: Choose a title that tells your reader what your paper will be about. You may choose your title after you write your paper if you are stuck, just be sure to leave room for it.

INTRODUCTION: Begin your paper with an introductory paragraph. Your introduction should let your reader know what is ahead by mentioning the three areas you will be writing about.

BODY: Choose three topics to write about on the subject of being home since the stay-home order.

Write one paragraph on each topic, with at least three sentences in each paragraph. Longer is fine.

Idea Questions: If you are stuck, the following are a few questions that may help you but *feel free to come up with your own ideas!*

Have you liked or disliked anything in particular? Has anything surprised you or frightened you or made you happy? Can you think of anything that would or would not have happened unless you were staying home? How was Easter different for you this year? What are you most looking forward to about things getting back to normal? Is there anything you will miss once things are back to normal? Have you learned anything from this experience, and if so, what?

CONCLUSION: Add a concluding paragraph to bring your paper to a close. Of all the areas you wrote about, choose the thing about being home that has made the strongest impression on you, and tell your reader why.
