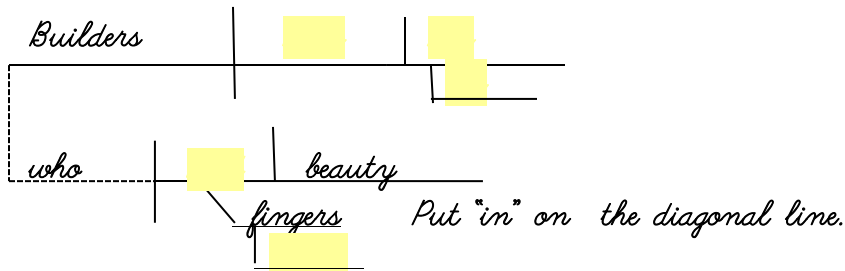
Grammar Assignment

hold : verb, strong, transitive, voice, mood, present tense, subject is "who," person, plural

beauty : noun, abstract, neuter, 3rd person, singular, direct object of "hold," objective case

key : noun, abstract, neuter, 3rd person, singular, direct object of "have," objective case
