

Kindergarten Science: Plants

1. Each plant part has a job.
2. Roots hold the plant in place.
3. Roots carry water and minerals from the soil to the plant.
4. Stems hold up the leaves and flowers.
5. Little tubes in the stems carry water and food to the rest of the plant.
6. A trunk is the stem of the tree. The trunk is the part of a tree that connects the leafy crown with its roots.
7. Leaves make food for plants.
8. A plant can make its own food using the green part of the leaves, water from the soil, gas from the air, and sunlight.
9. Flowers make the seeds for the plant.
10. Seeds grow into new plants.
11. Flowers need sunshine and water to grow.
12. People use plants in many ways. We eat plants to stay healthy. We get lumber and paper from trees, cloth from cotton plants, and gum from tree sap. People use plants to decorate our homes and to make medicines and dyes.
